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SHORT TENDERCALL NOTICE

The Project Director, Watersheds, Cuttack invites sealed tender on plain paper from intending bidders for collection of nuts and apples from the Cashew Plantation over 247.80 Ha. located inside Soil Conservation Demonstration Centre, Biswanahakani in the district of Cuttack during the year 2020 harvesting season on 19.02.2020 at or before 2 P.M. The tender will be opened by the Chairman of the Tender Committee on the same day at 3 P.M in presence of members of Tender Committee and the Tenderers or their representatives in the office of the Project Director, Watersheds-Cum-Deputy Director, Soil Conservation, Cuttack located at Kanika Road, Cuttack-8. The Tenderers should quote the price of the auction value of Cashew Plantation for collection of nuts and apples and an amount equal to 10% of the quoted value should be deposited along with the tender in shape of Bank draft/ Banker's cheque payable at Cuttack in favour of the Project Director, Watersheds-Cum- Deputy Director, Soil Conservation, Cuttack towards earnest money. Tenders should be sent through **Registered post or Speed post** duly superscribed with **"TENDER FOR COLLECTION OF RAW CASHEW NUTS & APPLES FROM THE PLANTATION AT BISWANAHAKANI"** and should be addressed to the Project Director, Watersheds-Cum-Deputy Director, Soil Conservation, Cuttack, Kanika Road, P.O.-Tulasipur Cuttack- 753008. **No hand delivery or courier delivery will be accepted.**

On acceptance of the tender, successful tenderer will have to deposit 10% towards security deposit and 50 % of the tender value after adjusting the E.M.D. on the same day. The balance quoted amount alongwith the **GST as applicable** over the total tender value is to be deposited within a week after which the work order will be issued, failing which the tenderer will have no right to collect nuts and apples from the said plantation and the order will be automatically cancelled with forfeiting of deposited earnest money.

The intending tenderers are advised to take registration under the GST acts to avoid double taxations on sale of cashew nuts. Other detail of terms and conditions can be ascertained from the office of the undersigned during office hours.

The department will not be responsible for any natural calamity. The competent authority reserves the right to accept or reject the tender without assigning any reason thereof. The department also reserves the right to collect seed & nuts from the Elite Cashew Plants marked in the plantation.
