Proceeding of the District Road Safety Committee Meeting held on 28-02-2023 by 4.00 PM at Sadbhabana Sabha Gruha, Collectorate, Cuttack

The meeting of the District Road Safety Committee was held on 28-02-2023 by 4.00 PM at Sadbhabana Sabha Gruha, Collectorate, Cuttack. Due to urgent nature of engagement of the Collector & District Magistrate-cum-Chairman DRSC, the meeting was conducted under the Chairmanship of Shri Purna Chandra Mishra, ADM (Revenue), Cuttack as advice by Chairman.

The members present in the meeting is attached herewith as Annexure-A.

At the outset, RTO and convenor of the committee welcomed all the members and office bearers present in the meeting and requested Shri Purna Chandra Mishra, ADM (Revenue), Cuttack to preside the meeting in absence of Collector & District Magistrate. ADM as Chairman I/C of the Committee welcomed all the members present in the meeting. Sri D.P.Patra Sri Kamaljeet Das, Sub Collector, Cuttack, DSP-cum-Enforcement officer of STA, Cuttack, Sri Sushant Kumar Singh, ACP Traffic and Sri Ajay Kumar Mohanty, Deputy Commissioner CMC had joined as special Invite.

It was noticed that other than S.E., Charbatia (R & B Division), Choudwar, Executive Engineer NH Division Cuttack and Executive Engineer NH Sub Division, Jagatsingh pur, no other Superintendent Engineers / Executive Engineers of the Works Department / Road Owning Authority as member were not present in the meeting. They had deputed the junior officers which is not allowed as only members of the committee are supposed to attend and they cannot substitute their junior officers to attend as member of the committee as per rule. Hence Chairman I/C and ADM (Revenue) was highly displeased and requested all the members to attend the next meeting physically since DRSC is a very important committee where Road Safety is directly involved. However their junior officers may attend the meeting as special invitee. CDMO, Cuttack and District Education Officer, Cuttack or their representative also did not attended the meeting.

Action: All Road Owing Agencies, CDMO, Dist. Education Officer.

ADM stressed upon reduction of Accidents and emphasised on creating awareness on Road Safety. He specifically advised the Road Owning Authority to repair the roads damaged and complete the new construction works as early as possible.

ACTION: All Superintendent Engineers/ Executive Engineers

As desired by Shri Purna Chandra Mishra, ADM (Revenue), Shri S K Behera, RTO continued as per the Agenda items of the meeting.

RTO informed the house that the General Secretary of the Cuttack Private Bus Association and member of the DRSC Sri Ajay Kumar Barik is no more and requested the house to observe One minute silent prayer to pay tribute to the departed soul. Accordingly one minute silent was observed.

The newly elected General Secretary of Cuttack Private Bus Association Sri Niranjan Sahoo is selected as the member of the committee in place of Late Ajay Kumar Barik. All the members including Chairman welcomed Sri Sahoo as member.

The committee approved the minutes of the proceeding of the last DRSC meeting held on 13-09-2022.

RTO informed the house that as per Letter No- 1177, Dated-01-02-2023 and Letter No- 1146, Dated- 01-02-2023 of Principal Secretary to Government, Commerce and Transport Department, addressed to all the Collectors, SP's, DCP's and RTO's the "Zero Fatality Week" to be observed throughout the state from 01st April to 07th April, 2023 and has requested for successful observance by all the stake holder departments like H & FW, Works, NH, NHAI, Home, H & UD, Education and Transport Department. As such this DRSC meeting is specifically conducted to ensure Zero Fatality during the week. The guideline issued for preparedness by each department is mentioned in the letter of the Principal Secretary which was read by RTO, Cuttack.

The job to be performed by different departments are:

H&FW Department:

- 1. Deployment of Ambulance on Highways at vulnerable locations in consultation with S.Ps/RTOs,
- 2. Trauma Care Centres to be in readiness round the clock

Action: CDMO, Cuttack

Works Department/ CGM, NHAI/ RD Department:

- 1. Putting adequate signages, road markings, speed limit Boards,
- 2. Deployment of manpower at the locations, where roads are under construction/ repairing
- 3. Traffic calming measures at the junctions
- 4. Provision of street lights on the roads/ junctions
- 5. Identify the Vulnerable spots and their rectification
- 6. Special drive to remove Pot holes on roads

Action: All Road Owing Authority

Home Department:

- 1. Stringent enforcement,
- 2. Arresting the Drunken drivers
- 3. Non-parking of vehicles on Highways
- 4. Conducting night checking
- 5. Activation of Highway patrol vehicles in the identified stretches

Action: DCP, Cuttack & Supdt. of Police, Cuttack

H&UD Department:

- 1. Removal of encroachment from Footpaths/Pedestrian paths
- 2. Identifying parking areas and ensuring non-parking of vehicles on road,
- 3. Removal of advertising board distracting drivers,
- 4. Stray animals not occupying the road

Action: All NAC's & CMC

Transport Department:

- 1. Conducting stringent enforcement
- 2. Filing of PR against drunken drivers
- 3. Activating the First Responders
- 4. Monitoring the activities of various Departments
- 5. Conducting Joint Enforcement with the support of Police
- 6. Enforcement of Fitment of retro reflective tapes in the vehicles

Action: R.T.O

Sri P.C.Mishra, ADM advised RTO to write each authority separately regarding the SOP made by STA for taking immediate action and preventive to address the Road Safety issues for observance of Zero Fatality week in the district. It should be the combined responsibility of all the departments to see that there is no fatality or major accidents during the week in our district.

The performance of highway patrolling by Police and use of the patrolling vehicle was found to be quite un-satisfactory as analyzed. ADM requested DCP & SP, Cuttack for review of the performance of the Highway patrolling and enhance the performance

Action: S.P, Cuttack & D.C.P, Cuttack

The committee suggested CDMO, Cuttack to take sincere steps in sending the names of the Good Samaritan to RTO, Cuttack by the Doctors available at Hospital on duty for rewarding the Good Samaritans to encourage the Good Samaritans.

Action: CDMO

NHAI Authorities were advised for repair of pot holes on NH and remove the un-authorize parking of vehicles. All the Road Owing Authorities requested to make their Road encroachment free with the help of local Police.

The Road Safety audit report made by STA was circulated by RTO since long to the concerned Road Owing Authorities to take action and submit compliance. But except Executive Engineer, NH Division, Cuttack and Jagatsingh pur no others have taken any action to that. If the Road Safety audit report is complied in true sense, the accident shall be minimum by 75%. Therefore ADM advised all the Road Owing Authorities for compliance of the Road Safety Audit report by 30-03-2023 positively and submit the report.

Action: All Road Owing Authority

It is also decided to conduct regular joint checking by RTO and Traffic Police inside the city for illegal parking and transportation of Sand loaded vehicles during bank period.

Action: RTO & ACP, Traffic

RTO proposed to organize Road Safety awareness programmes in 100 Nos. of High schools, particularly in road side schools with the help of members of Dist Road Safety forum for NGOs, Cuttack and for which submitted the budget of Rs 19,00,000/- for approval by the DRSC. The proposal was approved by the committee and suggested RTO to write STA for sanction of funds.

As per the request made by Gen. Secretary, All Odisha Bus Association regarding taking preventive steps at Pashupata Gada to avert accidents the SE, Choudwar R & B Divison intimated the Committee to look into the subject and he will put strip rumbler on the road.

Though as per the report of RTO, the number of accidents and death has been reduced in comparison to last year, but it has to be minimized by way of taking all the measures by concerned departments. Hence Sri P.C. Mishra, ADM, (Revenue) requested all the stake holders to work in co-ordination with each other and make the "Zero Fatality Week" a grand success.

The meeting was ended with vote of thanks to be chair and all members present in the meeting.
