

**Rehabilitation and Resettlement Plan for the Affected Families and Displaced Families of village-Guptamanika, PS-Kanpur in the Dist-Cuttack in connection with acquisition of land for construction of Hadua Dam Reservoir of Hadua Irrigation Project, Narasinghpur.**

**Brief description of the project.**

The Hadua Medium Irrigation Project is one of the medium irrigation project contemplated for integrated development of Narasinghpur, Badamba and Tigiria block of Cuttack district. The project envisages construction of a dam and a reservoir across the river Hadua, a tributary of river Mahanadi which is located near the village Kharod in Cuttack district and is about 94 k.m from Cuttack in Odisha state. The Project envisages construction of a 387 m long and 43.825 m height concrete dam besides a central Ogee crested spillway proposed in the dam across the river.

This medium irrigation project will provide irrigation facility to 3641 Ha of CCA out of 6205 Ha GCA with annual irrigation of 6598 Ha in the draught prone areas under Narasinghpur, Badamba and Tigiria Block of Cuttack District. The ayacut is located on the right side of Narasinghpur Branch Canal of Rengali Right Irrigation System.

**Location and accessibility:**

The Project is located in Badamba block of Cuttack district near village Kharod at Latitude 20° 27' 50" N and Longitude 85° 15' 30" E vide Toposheet No. 73 H/2, H/2 H/6 & H/7. The dam site situated at a distance of 100kms from Cuttack, the district headquarters. The nearest railway station of East Coast Railways is Athagarh which is 55kms away. The dam site is 130kms from the state capital and nearest airport, Bhubaneswar.

### Necessity of Project:

The Project area comes under Narasinghpur and Badamba block of Cuttack district, which is a draught prone area. The agricultural practice in this area completely depends upon the rainfall which is not dependable because of wide temporal & spatial distribution. As a result, the agricultural production is much below the average level. Agriculture being the main source of income, the per capita income of the people in this area is low, so the inhabitants of the locality continue with poor education, mal-nutrition and poverty. The construction of a dam across Hadua river, providing irrigation is absolutely necessary to improve the agricultural output and economy of the region to mitigate the misery of the population, mostly belonging to the scheduled caste and scheduled tribes and backward class. Creating the provision of irrigation in this drought prone area is absolutely necessary for the above-mentioned purposes.

### Villages coming under Hadua Reservoir

As a part of Hadua Irrigation Project, Hadua Reservoir Constitutes of 04 nos. of villages with an area of Ac.168.29 of private land of Cuttack District in the state of Odisha. Out of which 01 village is fully, 01 village is partly and rest 02 villages are affected cultivable land only. Guptamanika village is coming under partly submerged villages involving an area of Ac.89.73 to be acquired vide LA Case No-03/2022 & Notification No.1638, dtd.04.11.2022 under RFCTLA R&R Act-2013. As per SE&C Survey Report and joint verification / validation, 18 nos. of DFs are going to be displaced from Mahulmada hamlet of Guptamanika village. Agriculture as well as house-site land of the said village are affected for construction of Hadua Reservoir under H.I.P. Narasinghpur.

### Village - Guptamanika

Village-Guptamanika under Kanpur Police Station of Cuttack district is situated 92 km from District Headquarters, Cuttack and 97 km from the State Capital, Bhubaneswar. The nearest urban area, Hindol is situated at a distance of 30 km from the village.

### Survey and Census of the Affected Families & Displaced Families.

As required U/S-16(1) of the RFCTLA R&R Act-2013 door to door SE&C Survey and Census of the Affected Families and Displaced Families has been conducted by the Firm, Keshuv Informatics, Cuttack and the survey team i.e. R.I. and Amin of O/o the Spl. LA & R.O. HIP, Narasinghpur which has been verified by the Spl. LA & RO and Project Director(R&R), HIP, Narasinghpur. The detailed information has been mentioned in the Socio Economic Survey Booklet and in separate Case Records.

The abstract of Displaced Families(DFs) and Affected Families (AFs) of Guptamanika village are given below :

1. 18 nos. of DFs
2. 05 nos. of AFs (above 75%)
3. 52 nos. of AFs (below 75%)

The detailed particulars of the Displaced Families (DFs) are enclosed in a separate sheet in **Annexure-I**.

As required under Sub-section-(5) of Section-16 of the Act, Public Hearing was conducted at Kothaghar of village Guptamanika on 01.08.2023 at 3.00 PM after giving wide publicity about the date, time and venue for the public hearing at the affected area.

The Administrator, HIP (Spl. LA & RO and PD(R&R)) has also visited the houses of the families to be displaced.

The displaced families are entitled to get Rehabilitation package Under Section-16(1)(b) & as mentioned in **Second Schedule (Point No.1)** of the RECTLA R&R Act, 2013 in addition to those provided in the **First Schedule**.

The member of each family to be displaced has given their option of taking the R&R package against displacement as per the RFCTLA R&R, 2013 Act.

An affected family who is losing more than 75% or less than 75% of his total extent of land holding in the irrigation project area, he shall get the benefit as provided in items (a),(b),(c)&(d) under ORRP-2006 as per Sub-section-(2) of Section-108 of the RFCTLA R&R Act-2013 with an undertaking of the AFs concerned to this effect.

The copy of the same is enclosed with related Case Records.



As such the Rehabilitation and Resettlements package is being given to Displaced Families(DFs) as per Second Schedule of the RFCTLA R&R Act. 2013 and to the Affected Families(AFs) (<75% & >75%) as per R&R Policy 2006 - 8<sup>th</sup> Biennial Revision of Rehabilitation Grants in Monetary Terms communicated in Resolution Memo No.35133, Dt.17.10.2022 of Govt. R&DM Deptt.(O).Accordingly Draft R&R Plan with Entitlements is prepared which is enclosed in separate sheet as **Annexure-II**.

On completion of Draft R & R Plan, a public hearing is made in the village on 01.08.2023 and 06 nos. of complaints raised during the public hearing on the provisional Entitlement Matrix and draft R & R Plan out of which 04 nos. are included in the final list on proper verification of their documents and 02 cases were not considered. Accordingly their petitions were heard and disposed of in presence of the complainants on the spot.

On further scrutiny of the Provisional Entitlement list, it was detected that 187 nos. of Affected Families (>75%) are not ordinarily residing in or near the project area for which they are not eligible for getting Rehabilitation Package as AFs as per Letter No.42388, dtd.20.10.2010 of Govt. in R & DM Deptt.(O). Accordingly their names were deleted in final entitlement list and Entitlement list of 05 nos. of AFs (>75%) and 53 nos. of AFs (<75%) and 18 nos. of DFs was prepared.

As such, the draft Rehabilitation and Resettlement Plan and Estimate-cum-Entitlement Matrix of village- Guptamanika is recommended for kind perusal and review by the Collector, Cuttack being the Chairman of the Rehabilitation and Resettlement Committee constituted under Section-45 of the Act for onward transmission of the same to the Commissioner, Rehabilitation and Resettlement with his suggestion, if any, for approval of the Plan.

The Rehabilitation & Resettlement Plan is finalised as envisaged in Sub Section-6 of the Section-16 of the RFCTLA R&R Act-2013.
